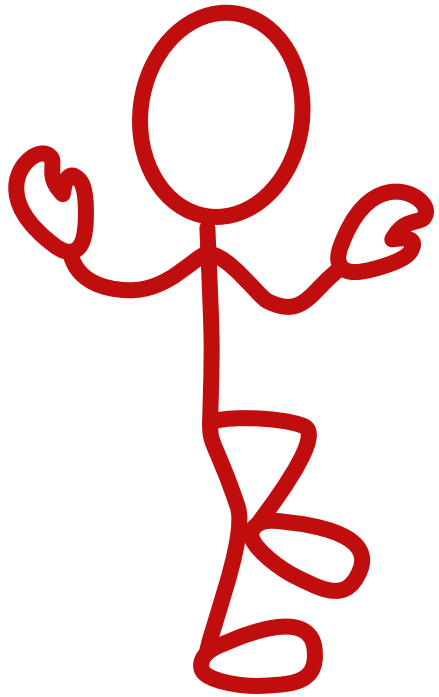

## Warm Up

## Main task

### Recap and revise

This lesson is ideally situated after a class maths test towards the end of the academic year which covers all areas of this unit.

After marking the test the teacher should consider the most poorly answered section of the test (for example: time tables, fractions, angles etc).

The teacher should recap the two areas of weakness in this lesson choosing the two action Maths lessons from this unit to repeat. They should split the space into two equal halves and set up the Mats as shown in the lesson above. The students should be grouped appropriately to ensure the students' weaker areas match the Maths Mat activity.

For example, if the group struggle on times tables and fractions the activity from lesson 1 and 4 or 5 should be repeated in this review lesson.
